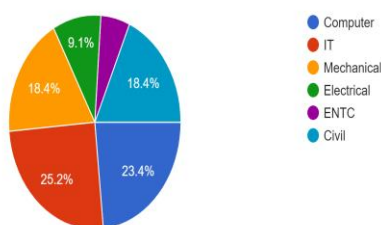
Outcome:

This survey appears to be making a genuine effort to gather feedback to improve the effectiveness of the experience

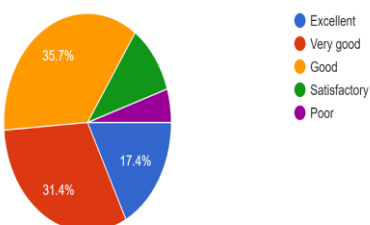
Student Satisfaction survey appears to be making genuine effort to gather feedback to overall improvement of the effectiveness for the students in the institute.

The result of the survey is shown in the form of Pie chart below.

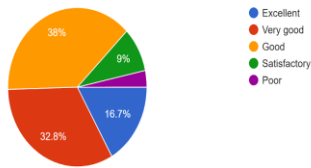

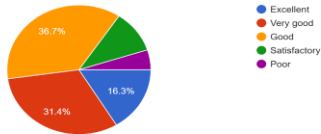
Q1a. How do you rate the content of the curriculum learnt so far in view of skills and knowledge for getting a job?

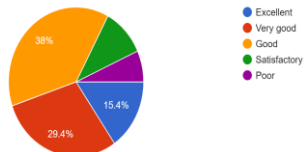
Q2a. How do you rate the content of the curriculum learnt so far in view of skills and knowledge for pursuing higher education?

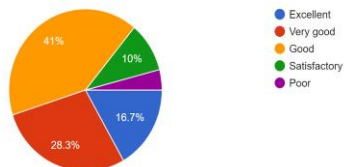
Q4a. How do you rate the content of the curriculum learnt so far in view of skills and knowledge for starting your own venture / startup?

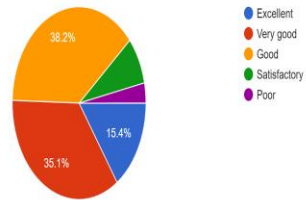

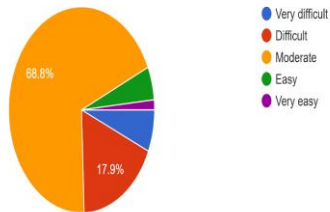
Q.6a. How do you rate balance between theory and practical?

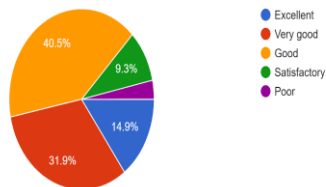
Q7a. How do you rate inclusion of other curricular components (project, seminar, examination)?

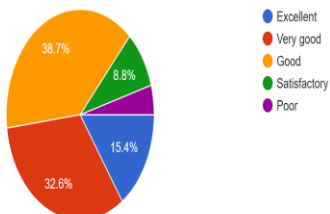
Q8a. How do you rate the difficulty level of the course content?

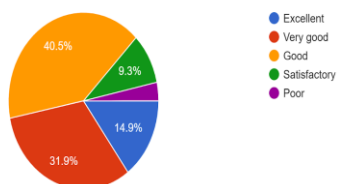
