Rules for Grant of additional marks for extracurricular activities

1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any other Ordinance, maximum fifteen (15) marks or maximum 0.15 CGPA may be granted to candidate appearing for examination for any degree, diploma or certificate, as an incentive, for his Participation in any one or more of the following activities:

- (a) National Cadet Corps;
- (b) National Services Scheme;
- (c) Sports: Savitribai Phule Pune University Inter- zonal Sports Tournaments/ Inter University Sports Tournament/ All India Inter University Sports Tournaments;
- (d) Cultural and Research Activity: Savitribai Phule Pune University Level or State Level Inter University/Inter-University Zonal Cultural (debating/elocution/dramatics etc.)/Research (Avishkar) or All India Inter-University Cultural (debating/elocution/dramatics, etc.)/Research (Anveshan) competition and such other competitions as approved by the Institute Head, from time to time.

(2) If the student fails in one or more heads of passing/courses. The additional marks shall be added

(a) To any head/s of passing or to any course/s, as case may be, in the examination if the student has failed in such head/s of passing /course/s and if such additional marks enable the student to get necessary passing marks or;

(b) To any subject, if such additional marks enable the student to get benefits of exemption.


Such additional marks only as are required for examination, shall be given.

After the grant of additional marks under clauses (a) and (b) above, if there is any balance of marks, the corresponding CGPA points against the balance marks shall be added to the CGPA, secured by the student in the academic year.

OR

(3) In case if students pass in all the heads of passing/ course/in that academic year, then the benefit can be granted in the form of an additional 0.15 CGPA point. These additional 0.15CGPA points shall be added to the CGPA, secured by the student in the academic year, subject to the condition that final CGPA of the student should not cross 10 points.

Provided that the additional marks/CGPA points shall not be taken into consideration for the purpose of award of any prize, scholarship, and merit list or for such other similar purposes.





(4) The additional marks/ CGPA points shall be granted to the student only for that academic year during the course of which the candidate has participated in the activities mentioned in Clause 1. These additional marks /CGPA points shall not be carried forward to the next academic year.

(5) Additional marks shall be granted to the student subject to the conditions mentioned hereunder:

(a) NCC:

(i) A Candidate who has enrolled in NCC and has attended 75% parades out of total number of parades and one annual training camp prescribed for NCC, will get 10 marks or 0.10 CGPA points.

(ii) Out of the cadets mentioned in Sub-Clause (i) above, those who have participated in National Integration Camp/National Thal Sena Camp/ R.D. Parade, New Delhi/ Army Attachment camp or a National Level Camp approved by NCC Group HeadQuarter, will get 5 marks or 0.05 CGPA points.

(iii) The cadres fulfilling the conditions mentioned in(i) and (ii) above at a time, will get a maximum 15 marks or 0.15 CGPA points in that particular academic year.

(b) NSS:

(i) A Candidate who has enrolled in NSS and has completed 120 hours of effective work and attended the necessary one special camp as required under NSS Programme and/or has participated in State Level 'Avhan' activity, will get 10 marks or 0.10 CGPA points.

(ii) A Candidate who has enrolled in NSS and has completed 120 hours of effective work and participated State Level and National Level R.D. Parade, will get 5 marks or 0.05 CGPA points.

OR

(ii) A Candidate who has enrolled in NSS and has completed 120 hours of effective work and participated in National/International Integration Camp/National Adventure Sports Camp, e.g. mountaineering, paragliding, skiing etc. organized by NSS on behalf of Youth Sports Mantralaya of Central Government, will get 05 marks or 0.05 CGPA points.

(iii) Candidates fulfilling the conditions mentioned in (i) and (ii) above at a time, will get maximum 15 marks or 0.15 CGPA points in that particular academic year.

(C) Sports:

(i) A Candidate participating in Pune University Inter zonal Sports Tournaments through Savitribai Phule Pune University Sports Departments, will get 5 marks or 0.05 CGPA points in that Particular academic Year.

(ii) A Candidate participating in State Level Inter University and/or West/South Zone Inter University and/or All India Inter University Sports Tournaments through Savitribai Phule Pune University Sports Departments, will get 10 marks or 0.10 CGPA points in that particular academic year.

OR

(iii) A Candidate participated in All India Inter University Sports Tournaments sponsored by Association of Indian Universities (A.I.U) New Delhi, and obtained first/second/third rank in that Sports Tournament, will get 15 marks or 0.15 CGPA points in that particular academic year.

(d) Cultural / Research Competition:

(i) A Candidate participating in Savitribai Phule Pune University Level Cultural/Research Competition of events approved by the Chancellor, will get 05 marks or 0.05 CGPA points in that Particular academic Year.

OR

(ii) A Candidate participated in State Level Inter/ University Zonal Cultural/Research (Avishkar) Competition through Savitribai Phule Pune University students, Welfare Department and obtained, first/second/third rank in that competition, will get 10 marks or 0.10 CGPA points in that particular academic year.

OR

(iii) A Candidate participated in All India Inter/ University Cultural/Research (Anveshan) Competition sponsored by Association of Indian Universities (A.I.U), New Delhi, through Savitribai Phule Pune University students, Welfare Department and obtained, first/second/third rank in that competition, will get 15 marks or 0.15 CGPA points in that particular academic year.

(5) A student shall submit an application in a prescribed format before the date of commencement of his/her examination for the grant of additional marks along with necessary original certificate/s or copies thereof countersigned by respective institute coordinator and Head of Department and approved by Principal.

(6) If any difficulty arises in giving effect to provisions of the Ordinance, the Principal may give his decision in such a particular case. The decision of the Principal shall be final and binding in such matters.
