Each batch completed a **7-day industrial training program** at the company's premises.

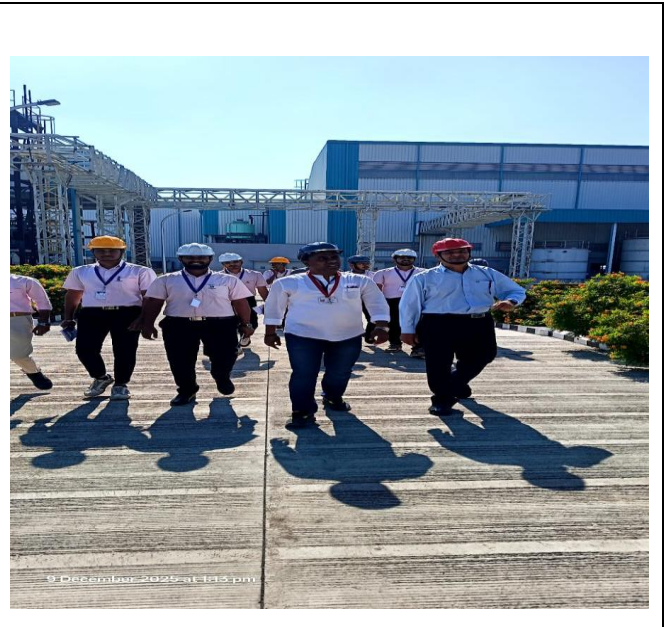
3. Objectives of the Internship

The signing of the MoU reflects mutual trust and commitment toward student development.

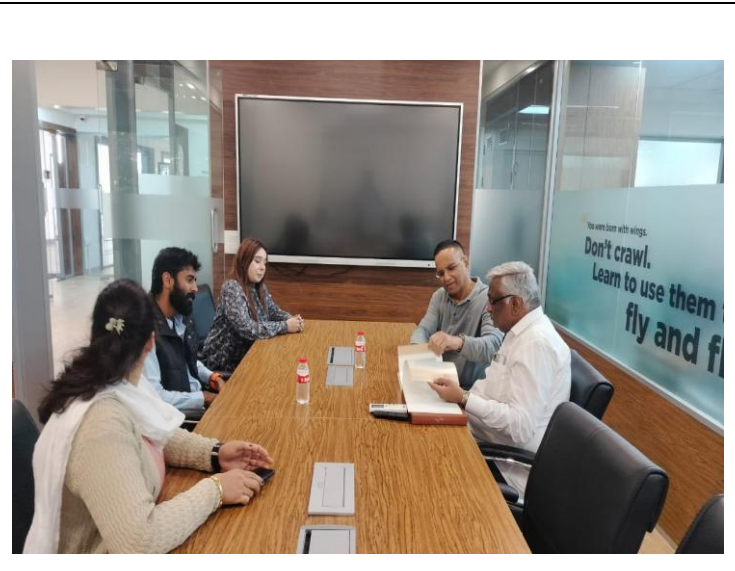
4. Address & Encouragement to Students
